

AVIAN FIELD TECHNICIAN (1) needed for desert thrasher surveys in Nevada. Great Basin Bird Observatory is seeking one field technician to conduct thrasher surveys in southern Nevada. Work is to be conducted between mid-March and mid-June, but exact timing is flexible. Duties include area searches focused on Bendire's and LeConte's thrashers and Loggerhead Shrikes, though all bird species are recorded, and data entry. Good bird identification skills, and willingness to work independently in remote areas, including operation of 4wd vehicles, are essential. This position will involve extensive travel and camping throughout southern Nevada, with shared housing provided. Field vehicle will be provided. Surveyor will be hired as a seasonal temporary GBBO employee and paid \$2200-\$2400/month depending on experience. GBBO policy requires all technicians to show proof of full COVID-19 vaccination or an approved exemption.
